



## **Tool Kit for Time to Deliver Baby Shower-Themed Info Tables**

***GRANs, we have assembled this menu of materials to help you set up your info tables. These resources are designed to help get attention, raise awareness, and encourage signatures. Use the ones that you think will best work for you.***

- [QR code](#) that takes people right to the Time to Deliver petition. Print it and display it prominently.
- [Bookmarks](#) – Have these printed at your local print shop on sturdy cardstock and use as free give-aways. They hold a QR code that takes people to the Time to Deliver petition, as well as the website address. **(Tell your print shop that the file includes both front and back, as well as all the printer marks, and that they need to be printed at 1.75 inches x 6 inches and then cut.)** If you are able to print on cardstock on your home colour printer, use [this file](#) instead for home printing. (You may wish to approach your local library or independent bookstore to see if they might be willing to accept a stack of bookmarks for patrons/customers to take away. Another way to get the word out!)

**Reimbursement:** Some funds are available on a first-come first-served basis to help cover printing costs. Once approved, have your bookmarks printed and submit your receipt to Sue for reimbursement.

- [Water Droplet templates](#) – Ask people to write on the droplet why they think world leaders should deliver clean water to health care centres. Display the droplets on a board. Take a photo of your display to send in to us. We will share them with WaterAid. They want to create a “wave” of droplet photos from all around the world to take to the UN Water Conference in December.
